How does North Districts Community Credit Union collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ open an account or deposit money into an account ■ pay your bills or apply for a loan ■ use your credit or debit card <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ■ affiliates from using your information to market you ■ sharing for nonaffiliates to market you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>

Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>CUNA Insurance, Equifax Credit Bureau, AMIS, Liberty Check, VISA, Mid-Atlantic Corporate Federal Credit Union</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ N/A
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ North Districts Community Credit Union has no formal joint marketing agreements.
